My time at Drew London has been a fulfilling and ever-challenging role, spanning everything from handling client relations to delivering fully equipped WordPress websites. I have managed and helped deliver over 45 sites while at Drew, managing current clients Drew has had for years and brand new clients. The breadth of Drew's client portfolio meant I have experience working with companies as large as M&G Investments, to luxury shoe brands and everything in between. As a small team of 4 developers with me leading the team, we are able to work quickly and efficiently to develop stunning websites for our clients.

Every website we build is a custom Wordpress site including a custom theme. We do this because having tried to use off-the-shelf themes, this rarely saves you time. As a client's wants and expectations will move past a theme very quickly. This results in more work trying to fit it to what the client wants whereas if we start from custom, we only build what we need. This results in a much faster website, with less unused code and bloat. A custom approach also allows us more flexibility and creativity in our website designs as we are only restricted by what we think we can achieve and nothing else. You can see this for yourself in the beautiful and thoughtfully designed websites I have delivered while at Drew such as It's All Blakademik, Rash&Rash and SRG Movement. I have developed good skills in both PHP and Liquid having worked with both in-depth while at Drew. My time there has also expanded my knowledge of deployment methods for websites. I have maintained a Capistrano based development method and helped implement a CircleCi method for more advanced sites going forward.

My time at Drew has also allowed me to improve my skills in client relations. As the only full-time developer at Drew, it is necessary that I am involved in client meetings from the start, so that we can give them a realistic quote and timeframe. I will then be involved in communicating directly with the client from then on, as I feel it is good for clients to hear from a developer as well as a project manager. The extra technical knowledge can help reassure a client and calm any fears or worries they may have before or during a project. At Drew, I will speak to clients nearly every day. Meaning I now feel very comfortable in a client-facing role and would like to expand on it going forward.
